COMPACT CAR RULES

ALL RULES APPLYING TO FULL SIZE CARS WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:

1. Wheel base is to be measured with the following restrictions:
108 inches from the center of front wheel to the center of back wheel.
2. Tire size will be limited to 15 inch automotive tires **ONLY**.
3. Engine size can be either 4 or 6 cylinder
4. Driver's door must be white. Number(s) must be 20 inches or larger with black paint and must also have number on top of car for judging and recognition.

FULL SIZE CAR RULES

1. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE IN & REGISTERED 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO STARTING OR THE ENTRY FEE WILL BE DOUBLED ***** NO EXCEPTIONS**
2. All drivers must be 18 or parents must sign consent waiver.
3. Absolutely **NO ALCOHOL** allowed in the pits as well as in the arena
4. **ONE** support vehicle per entry
5. Driver's meeting will be held 30 minutes **PRIOR** to start of derby
6. Driver's door must be white. Number(s) must be 20 inches or longer with black paint and must also have number on top of car for judging and recognition.
7. Any passenger car or wagon 1980 & newer allowed. Minimum 110" wheelbase required.
No trucks, ambulances, imperials, or checkers allowed.
8. Seat belts & helmets required and must be worn at **ALL** times when in a car during a derby heat.
9. One automotive type 12 volt battery.
10. Battery should be secured, covered, & placed in front floorboard of cab of vehicle.
11. No glass, chrome, or molding.
12. No welding on frame. No reinforcing frame. Welding doors is optional, but must be at least chained.
13. For safety precautions, driver's door must be reinforced. Hood, trunk, & tailgates must be chained Please no welding.
14. Hood & trunk must be either chained or all thread rod may be used. Limited to 4 all thread rod not exceeding 3/4 inch in diameter per hood & trunk. All thread rod may go through frame but not welded to frame.
15. If chains are used in hood: the radiator area must not be blocked. Chains must be either side of the middle of the radiator.
16. Only 15 inch size tires are allowed. No fluid or sand in tires allowed. (Must be automotive tires)
17. At least, one 14 inch hole in hood or if running a breather at least two 10 inch holes required
18. **NO CHANGING OF SUSPENSION.** No use of longer shackles or spring adjusters, no air shocks, no double springs, no cranking up torsion bars. Cars must have bounce. Chains, cables, and/or wire wrapped around suspension is optional.
19. All engines must be mounted in factory position. Solid mounts may be used.
20. Gas tank is at the discretion of the driver on whether it is a stock gas tank or metal/plastic marine tank. Gas tank must be secured inside the vehicle & positioned in the back seat floorboard area behind the driver's seat. Pump gas/gasoline only.
21. Transmission cooler may be moved to back seat area or on top of the car, but must be in a self-contained metallic box and be secured.
22. Valve stem protectors are allowed
23. Headers must be in vertical position
24. Radiators must be in stock position. **WATER ONLY** in radiators.
25. Any car bumper can be used on any car, but must be in stock position. It must be bolted on or can be spot welded only (equaling 1 inch or less per bolt)
26. A support bar across firewall & behind driver's seat with added brace in middle providing: it does not go beyond rear axle is optional.
27. A proctor bar **MUST** be placed in the middle of the windshield area.
28. Semi wet track
29. Aggressive contact must be made every 1 minute.
30. Drivers must stay in car with helmets and seat belts on until heat is over.
31. If car stalls during race, driver will have 2 minutes to restart and resume derby.
32. No intentional hitting on driver's door. If so, driver & car will be disqualified for the heat. This will be a judgement ruling.
33. **ALL DECISIONS MADE BY THE OFFICIALS ARE FINAL**
