1. Exhibitors are limited to one (1) entry in each class.
2. Articles that have been purchased at the market are not eligible.
3. All field crop exhibits must have been produced during the last harvest season.
4. Commercial brand names will not be permitted on field crop exhibits.
5. Exhibits showing evidence of decay will be removed at the discretion of the Superintendent.

Premiums for all exhibits shall be paid as follows:

1st - \$3.00 2nd - \$2.00 3rd - \$1.00

GARDEN PRODUCE / HORTICULTURE

- 01 Beans, Lima – plate of twelve (12) pods
- 02 Beans, green, yellow, or purple – plate of twelve (12) pods.
- 03 Beets, tops on, plate of five (5)
- 04 Cabbage, best head
- 05 Carrots, tops on, plate of five (5)
- 06 Cucumbers, plate of two (2)
- 07 Eggplant, plate of three (3)
- 08 Okra, plate of five (5)
- 09 Onions, plate of five (5)
- 10 Peppers, sweet, plate of five (5)
- 11 Peppers, hot, plate of twelve (12)
- 12 Potatoes, white, 3-5 lbs
- 13 Potatoes, red, 3-5 lbs
- 14 Peas, twelve (12) pods
- 15 Squash, summer, one (1)
- 16 Rhubarb, bunch of five (5) stalks
- 17 Sweet Corn, plate of three (3)
- 18 Tomatoes, plate of three (3) red or pink, standard size
- 19 Tomatoes, salad, plate of five (5)
- 20 Apples, red, plate of five (5)
- 21 Apples, any other variety, plate of five (5)
- 22 Peaches, yellow, plate of five (5)
- 23 Peaches, any other variety, plate of five (5)
- 24 Grapes, plate of five (5) clusters
- 25 Oddity of nature of any Farm Crop or Garden Produce above.
- 26 Any other vegetable not listed above

FARM CROPS

Hybrid Corn

- 30 Yellow Corn, any variety, five (5) stalks bundled
- 31 White Corn, any variety, five (5) stalks, bundled

Wheat

- 32 Soft Winter Wheat, pint jar (previous harvest season)

Legumes

- 33 Soybeans, five (5) stalks bundled

Small, seeded legumes (All entries shall be in a clear one (1) pint jar with lid.)

- 34 Lespedeza, any variety
- 35 Red Clover
- 36 Sweet Clover

Grasses (All entries shall be in a clear one (1) pint jar with lid.)

- 37 Timothy
- 38 Orchard Grass
- 39 Red Top
- 40 Fescue

Hay & Straw

- 41 Hay, one (1) bale of Red Clover
- 42 Hay, one (1) bale of cured Alfalfa
- 43 Hay, one (1) bale of mixed Grasses (two (2) or more kinds of Grass)
- 44 Straw, one (1) bale

Sunflowers

- 45 Sunflower, ornamental, one (1) head under 12"
- 46 Sunflower, ornamental, one (1) head over 12"
